NP & 1st Ave. N. Corridor Study Public Meeting

FARGO, N.D. (February 18, 2010) – A public meeting regarding the NP and 1st Avenue North corridor study will be held on **Tuesday, March 2 from 5-7 p.m.** at the Main Fargo Public Library, 102 3rd Street North. **The formal presentation will begin at 5:30.** The City of Fargo and project consultants will present roadway and pedestrian alternatives for the NP and 1st Avenue North corridor and answer questions from residents.

The purpose of the study is to evaluate the potential benefits and drawbacks of altering the existing one-way street system along NP Avenue and 1st Avenue North in Downtown Fargo. Several alternatives have been developed. The impact of each alternative has been evaluated using data associated with traffic operations, pedestrians and cyclists, the downtown economy, transit operations and streetscape features.

This is the second of three public meetings to be held regarding the corridor study. All are invited to attend to learn more and offer thoughts regarding the proposed alternatives.
